JOB SUMMARY

The Volleyball Animator is responsible for the daily operations of the beach volleyball program. They manage the rotation of all the players throughout 7 courts, collect money, and keep records of activities up to date. The animator also plays a crucial role in promoting sportsmanship on the premises, to provide a positive environment for all, regardless of the level of play. The work takes place mostly outside, if the weather permits.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for setting up and taking down the lines, managing the balls, and all the equipment needed for the activity.
- Manage membership cards and daily fees.
- Coordinate player rotation across all the playing fields.
- Fill out incident reports if applicable.
- Fill out daily reports.
- Keep the playing fields and cabin clean.

- At least 1 year of customer service or animation experience.
- Valid first aid and CPR certificate (Valid at the beginning of the season).
- Good communication and teamwork skills.
- Bilingual in French and English (speaking another language is an asset).
- Energetic and dynamic.
- Passion for sports (Volleyball is an asset).
